

ANN'S STAR

King Size 110x110

Cutting Instructions:

FABRIC 1 - (Center Block and 2nd Border)

Cut 1 strip 20- 1/2". Cut 1 square 20 -1/2".

Cut 9 strips 9 -1/2" for border.

FABRIC 2 - (Large Points of Star and 1st Border and Binding)

Cut 2 strips 10 -7/8". Cut into 4 squares 10 -7/8" and then cut in half diagonally for 8 star points. Cut 9 strips 5 -1/2" for 1st border. Remaining fabric for binding.

FABRIC 3 - (Small Points of Star and Sawtooth -3rd Border)

Cut 2 strips 5 -7/8". Cut into 8 - 5- 7/8" squares and then cut in half diagonally for 16 triangles.

Cut 1 strip 11 -1/4". Cut 1 square 11- 1/4". Cut square diagonally twice for 4 triangles. From the 11 -1/4" strip also cut 4 squares 5 -1/2".

Cut 4 strips 6-7/8". Cut into 24 - 6 -7/8" squares. Cut in half diagonally for 48 triangles.

From leftover strips cut 4 - 5 -1/2" squares, 4 - 6 -1/2" squares and 4 - 3 -1/2" squares.

FABRIC 4 - (Star Background, Sawtooth-3rd Border & Fourth Border)

Cut 2 strips 5 -7/8". Cut into 8 - 5 -7/8" squares and then cut in half diagonally for 16 triangles.


Cut 1 strip 11- 1/4". Cut 1 square 11-1/4". Cut square diagonally twice for 4 triangles. From the 11- 1/4" strip also cut 4 - 5 -1/2" squares.

Cut 4 strips 6- 7/8". Cut into 24 - 6 -7/8" squares and cut in half diagonally for 48 triangles.

Cut 5 - 5 -1/2" strips. Cut 10 - 3" strips (4th Border)

Cut 4 - 6 -1/2" squares from leftover strips.

FABRIC 5 - (Fifth Border) Cut 10 - 8" strips for outside border.



Assembling Center Block:

1. Using Fabric 2 and 3, make 4 flying geese units. Start by sewing one small triangle to large triangle, press then sew small triangle to opposite side of large triangle and press again.



Make 4.

2. Sew small triangles to either side of flying geese block and press.

3. Sew large triangle to top of flying geese blocks and press.

4. Now add large star triangle points to each side of block. Press after sewing on each seam. Repeat these steps until you have 4 blocks that look like this one.




Make 4.

5. Sew 8 triangle sets of Fabric 2 and 3 using small triangles. Press.



Make 8.

6. Now sew two triangle blocks to a solid block of Fabric 2 and 3. Note the placement of the triangle block.



Make 4.

7. Sew two blocks from Step 4 to each side of 20 - 1/2" center square. Press.



8. Now sew the corner blocks to the other two triangle blocks. Press and sew on to the center block from Step 7. Refer to block picture on page 1.



Make 2 sets.

9. Star block should measure 40 - 1/2". Sew to each side of star a 5- 1/2" x 40- 1/2" strip of Fabric 4. Press. Sew to top and bottom of star block a 5- 1/2" x 50- 1/2" strip. Press.

10. For Sawtooth Border, sew together 48 triangles of Fabric 3 & 4 to make 48 - 6 - 1/2" blocks. Press.



Make 48.

11. Layout squares according to picture on page 1. Each border has a 6- 1/2" square of Fabric 4 in the center. Assemble all 4 rows and press.

BORDERS: Add borders to star center by adding sides first, then top and bottom. Press after each border. **Add cornerstone blocks to Borders 3, 4 and 5.*

- 1st Border (Fabric 2) 2 - 5 - 1/2" x 50-1/2", 2 - 5 - 1/2" x 60 - 1/2"
- 2nd Border (Fabric 1) 2 - 9-1/2" x 62 - 1/2", 2 - 9 - 1/2" x 80 - 1/2"
- 3rd Border (Sawtooth Border)
- 4th Border (Fabric 4) 4 - 3 - 1/2" x 92 - 1/2"
- 5th Border (Fabric 5) 4 - 6 - 1/2" x 98 - 1/2"

NOTE: Borders are made by sewing together strips to get the desired length. **TIP:** *To keep borders from getting too stretchy, keep the strips you are sewing on the bottom. Pin the strip on and do not remove your pins until you are done sewing. Sew very slowly over flower pins and you will have more accurate borders.*

Quilt as desired and bind with remaining fabric. Cut 11 - 2" strips for binding.
